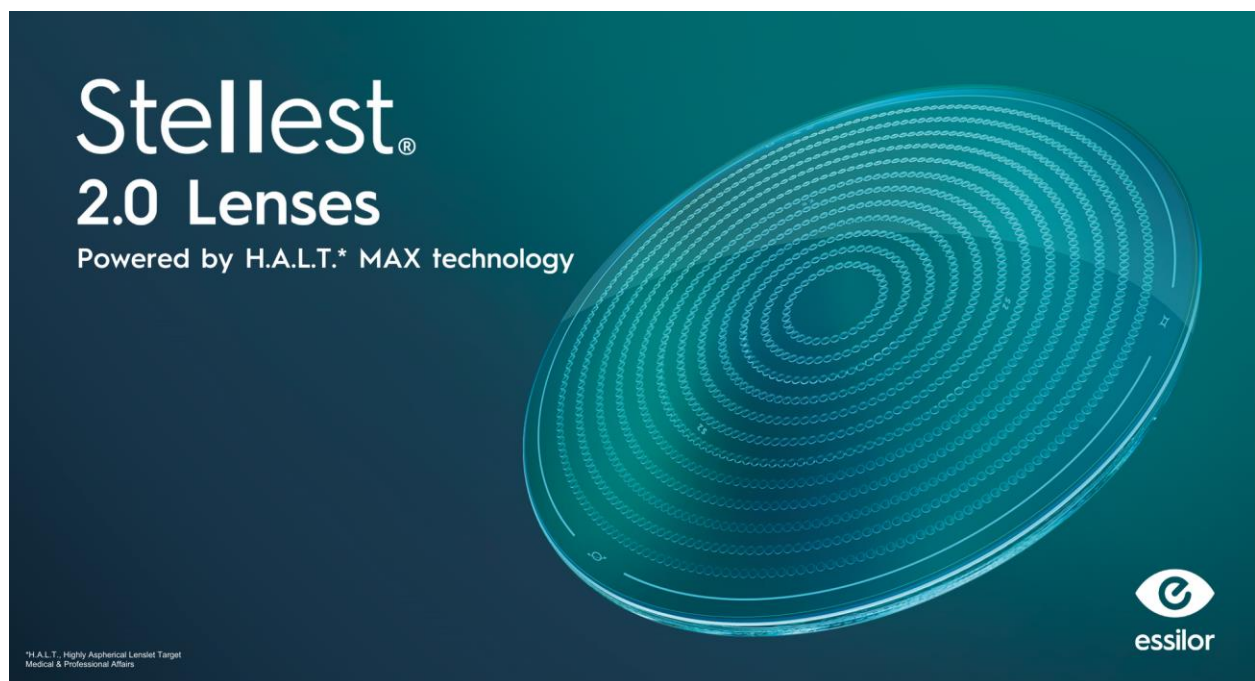




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EssilorLuxottica expands its myopia management solutions in Canada with Essilor® Stellest® 2.0 lenses

Clinical evidence from a 12-month randomized, double-masked trial conducted in Singapore confirms that Essilor® Stellest® 2.0 lenses significantly reduce axial elongation compared to the original Essilor® Stellest® lenses, while maintaining uncompromised visual clarity for children as young as six years old.
