KŌJI

Inspired by the harmony of traditional Japanese craftsmanship and modern innovation, this collection celebrates the seamless blend of form and function featuring our innovative flex hinge design that offers unparalleled comfort and durability.

Carved from a full block of the lightest aluminum, an innovative interplay of solids and voids create an exceptional flexibility to the temples. Each pair reflects beauty in simplicity and transient elegance, while embracing cutting-edge engineering reminiscent of ancient Japanese artisans. The rim inserts give a tridimensional depth to the front, while the car surface oil finishes adds a high tech feel. With Kōji wearers experience the perfect blend of tradition and innovation, where flexibility meets timeless style, allowing eyewear to adapt gracefully to any face.



KAIZEN THIN

Following the Japanese meaning of Kaizen, "continuous improvement", the sophisticated merge of acetate and aluminum has become smoother, in an even more refined balance of volumes. The Kaizen Thin collection pursues the need for lightness and leisure of the contemporary times becoming the better version of its previous self.

The sleek feeling of the counterpoise between the monoblock titanium and the aluminum inserts are highlighted by the unexpected hues combination in the collection.

TAISHO TITAN TOP

The monoblock Japanese Takiron's unique bold architectural feeling is enriched by a see-through effect that comes within the titanium inserts on the front. A tactile metallic element becomes the new core of the frames, while the updated temples with a raw cut faceting add a modern brutalist effect to the whole design. Inspired by the Taisho flourishing era, the new duplex hinge is the most innovative addition to this family, assuring a never tried before smooth closure.

GOLDEN FEVER

Japanese and Italian cultures come together once again, reinterpreting the use of gold in Miga Studio's SS26 collection. A symbol of wealth and imperfection, gold enriches the design of the new collection with meticulous respect for materials: Takiron acetate, high-tech titanium, and the new addition of aluminum punctuate the narrative of the new release, responding to the contemporary need for delicacy and lightness.

The metallic effect of the color emphasizes the high-tech mood of the collection in line with the brand's futuristic vision, where past and present merge between tradition and technology.
